



Hope Wall



The UNITE Hope Wall was unveiled August 16, 2013, to **celebrate sobriety** from addiction and to give hope to others struggling with their own or a loved one's addiction.

This 20-foot-wide serpentine display features between 180-200 photos of individuals who are now in recovery and living clean and sober lives. In addition to a picture, each panel includes the person's age of first-time drug use, date of sobriety, and a statement about what sobriety means to them.

To be eligible for inclusion on the wall, a person must have at least 18 months of sobriety.

The wall demonstrates that addiction has no boundaries and that all walks of life are affected by this disease. It also demonstrates that there is HOPE for each individual who desires to overcome the grips of an addiction.
