

Hope Wall



The UNITE Hope Wall was unveiled August 16, 2013, to **celebrate sobriety** and to give Hope to others struggling with their own or a loved one's substance use disorder.

This 20-foot-wide serpentine display features approximately 200 photos of individuals who are now in long-term recovery and living sober lives. In addition to a picture, each panel includes the person's age of first-time drug use, their date of sobriety, and a statement about what sobriety means to them.

To be eligible for inclusion on the wall, a person must have at least 18 months of sobriety.

The wall demonstrates that addiction has no boundaries and that all walks of life are affected by this disease. It also demonstrates that there is HOPE for each individual. By creating hope, we change the culture.
