

UNITE Treatment Voucher Program



Residents within UNITE's 32-county service region who have a substance use disorder may be able to receive financial assistance for long-term residential treatment through Operation UNITE's Treatment Voucher Program.

UNITE will pay a provider \$60 per day for long-term (90 days) residential treatment for adults and juveniles.

Detoxification treatments are not covered.

Eligibility Requirements

In order to qualify for a UNITE Treatment Voucher, applicants must:

- Verify they have been a resident of the UNITE service area within the last 30 days.
- Meet income guidelines based on household size.
- Complete an assessment screening with a UNITE staff member.

Applicants are NOT eligible if:

- They do not freely admit they have a substance use disorder.
- They have received 2 previous UNITE Treatment Vouchers.
- They have a pending criminal charge or active bench warrant, unless prior court approval is provided.

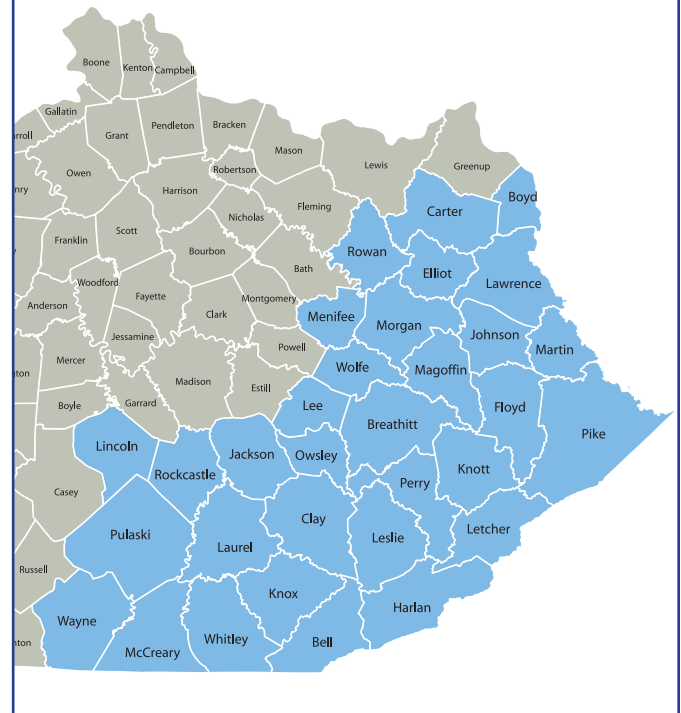
Next Steps

When all eligibility requirements have been met, he or she will be contacted by a UNITE Treatment Team member who will provide treatment recommendations.

Participants make the final decision regarding what treatment facility to enter (unless court-ordered to a specific facility).

Priority will be given to pregnant women, participants with no treatment history, intravenous drug users, and those ordered to treatment through Casey's Law.
